

Expeditions 362 (Sumatra Seismogenic Zone) and 362T (Transit/Hole U1473 Remediation) cores received

On the 2nd November 2016, the KCC received ca. 1.1 km of cores recovered from the Indian Ocean by the US drill ship JOIDES Resolution during the IODP Expeditions 362 (Sumatra Seismogenic Zone) and 362T (Transit/Hole U1473 Remediation), respectively. The cores were brought under refrigeration in 40-foot container from Singapore, where the ship made a port call soon after the Expedition 362 and offloaded the cores. All these cores are temporarily stored for a few days on their pallets in the KCC reefer aisle to facilitate sorting of the core boxes and sequential racking of cores in the new reefer. With this addition of the cores from the Indian Ocean, the KCC's IODP core collection has grown to ca. 118 km.
