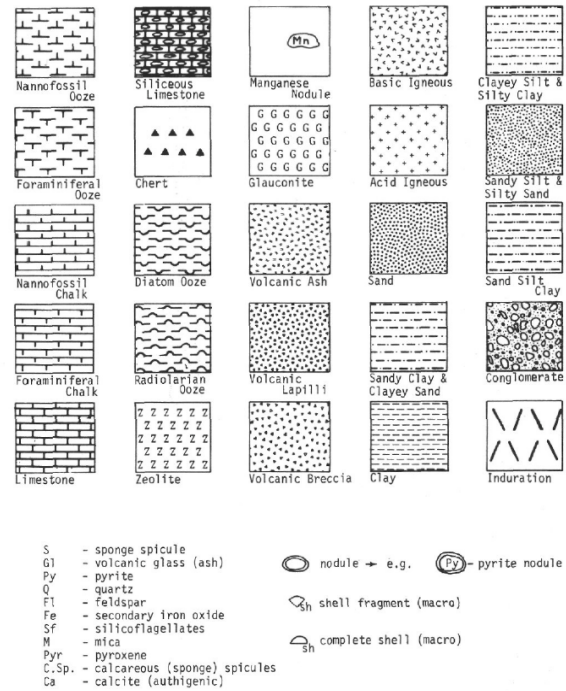


Figure 5. Standard symbols used to illustrate lithology.

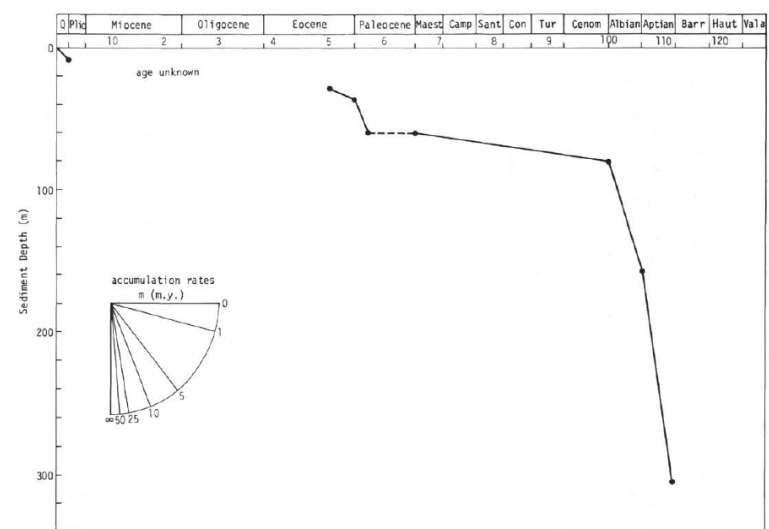


Figure 6. Sediment accumulation rates. Site 259.
