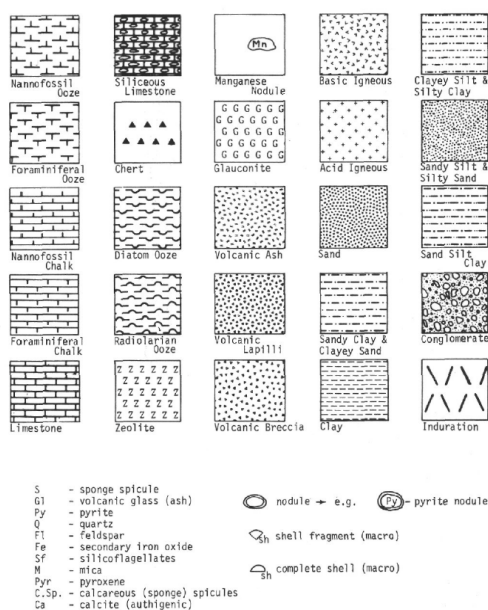


Figure 5. Standard symbols used to illustrate lithology.
